The Post Scarcity Institute (PSI) is currently seeking a Program Manager. This is a full-time position, based in the Nosara area of Costa Rica.

We are seeking a Program Manager who is passionate about both the design and operational aspects of the Post Scarcity Institute's programs.

The ideal candidate for this position is an experienced permaculture designer and implementer, someone who is deeply interested in implementing truly sustainable systems and is inspired by the prospect of exploring new solutions to local challenges. We are looking for a person who is a hands-on manager and enjoys being in the field.

The PSI uses permaculture, agroforestry, and other sustainability methodologies to enable human and native flourishing in the Guanacaste province of Costa Rica. The PSI is a new organization, having been established in 2021 as part of a larger project called Tierramor. The PSI is a center for learning and discovering ways of living and being. At its essence, the PSI seeks harmony between diversity and productivity - two things that are, all too often, perceived as mutually exclusive in our modern world. The PSI simultaneously pursues innovation and deeply values ancient wisdom.

The PSI cohabits an incredible 140 hectares of land with Tierramor. Tierramor is the center for consciousness which, at its core, seeks to bring people back into alignment with their primary human needs - connection, nourishment of the body and the soul, and belonging. The PSI is the steward of the land and runs regenerative programs in and around the various aspects of Tierramor - its temples, retreat center, and community. The PSI is also deeply involved in the design of the overall project, providing Tierramor with integrated food, energy, and water systems.

The Program Manager will play a key role in program design and setting the parameters for the project at large. This will be in collaboration with the permaculture designer, the PSI's Executive Director, and Tierramor's Founder. Importantly, the Program Manager will oversee the implementation of the PSI's programs. This will involve the day-to-day management of local staff as well as volunteers. This is a position for someone who is simultaneously a thinker and a doer and is able to take responsibility for teams.

A deep passion for permaculture and or/allied sustainability frameworks is absolutely essential for this role. Our ideal candidate has extensive knowledge and experience of tropical permaculture. We are, however, open to experienced permaculturalists from other climates who are eager to learn about Costa Rica.

The Program Manager needs to have strong leadership, management, and communication skills. Proficiency in Spanish is essential for this position.
